MEETING MINUTES

- 1. Meeting convened at 1:05 PM
- 2. Quorum was not established with only 6/13 members attending. Present in person: Carl Guse and Todd Lindert. Present via teleconference: Jim Jarvis, Paul Susienka, Marie Treazise and Jim Westover.
- 3. Minutes from the July 24, 2019 meeting will be reviewed at the next meeting due to lack of quorum.
- 4. Public Comment There was no public comment.
- 5. Old Business
 - A. Discussion of a Recommendation for Air Ground Medical LZ Coordination.
 - It was proposed that the coordinated channels should be Fireground Gray/and 8TACGray as a primary channel and Fireground Black/8TACBlack as the secondary channel.
 - Westover and Josh Ripp will contact MABAS Communications Board to present the case for mandating these channels.
 - Ripp and Jeff Grimm will work on gathering data to identify what areas of the state are presently patching something to MARC 2 or using 800mhz alone to connect ground units to aircraft in the state.
 - Lindert suggested that a brochure be created to help educate users throughout the state.
 Westover will work on drafting that document.
 - Based on the discussion, the subcommittee would like to establish permanent alternate channels for air-to-air and air-to-ground communications (these channels would not be available for other use).
 - The subcommittee would like to discuss this at the next joint LMR/WISCOM Subcommittee Meeting.

6. New Business

- A. Review and Possible Action to Approve the RF Gateway Approval Policy
 - This policy was described to the group but was not ready for full review and approval at the time of the meeting.
