Virtual MEETING MINUTES

1. Meeting Convened at 1305.
2. Quorum was not established with 6 /14 members present.

 - A. Review and Approval of the May 20, 2021 Meeting Minutes not approved due to no quorum

6. Zieke provided update on Patriot and use of broadband. JPS VIA and FirstNet ePTT used successfully.
7. Chair Hughes requested secretarial help

 - A. Chair Hughes discussed how prior conversation between himself, Chair Klein, Zieke, and CISA went
 - 1) Discussing ways that CISA is offering to help PSB SC
 - B. Ideas
 - 1) Developing a survey (well-made)
 - Their office can help develop the questions, and we can use the results to develop future taskings
 - (a) E.g., how to work with PTT app, etc.
 - 2) Using LTE AAR comments to drive product results and taskings
 - Chair Hughes discussed AAR that was taking place today in SEOC
 - 3) ATT ePTT and how to drive cross-connection between ATT/FN subscribers. Briefly described the issue
 - Possibility for generating letter to discuss this further with the IC
 - Described issue with ePTT vs MCPTT—two products getting mixed up, and Firstnet is shunting people to ePTT, which is a commercial product that does not meet public safety needs
 - (a) iOS not available for MCPTT, just android
 - (b) Two products, which are not interoperable, are being pushed out, and many of public sector side are getting confused (including State of WI).
 - (i) Per DC Formea, no sense that firstnet.com does not appear to have any drive to push current public ePTT subscribers to MCPTT
 - (ii) Member Rutyna offered to bring this up to the fed level
 - (iii) Zieke will link up with Member Rutyna and D/C Formea
 - (iv)
