9. WIFOG Update

-A Technical Assistance Grant through CISA was used to help develop WIFOG 2.0. The Lafayette Group as part of the TA has been helping with the development of the new WIFOG which is a combination of WIFOG 1.0 and Annex K into one document.

-Guse asked if a draft would be available for review prior to it coming before the LMR committee for final approval. Margaret said when she hears back from a couple people yet she should be able to send something out next week possibly. She is waiting for information regarding the tribal nations such as maps and contact information. Eric Boulanger said he would reach out and try to help her get this information. Margaret said because of the upcoming changes to the states new radio system to keep track of any changes that you feel need to be made with the next version of the WIFOG. She also said that after the printed version is complete it will be turned over to the developers to create an eWIFOG.
