- 3. Meeting Minutes
  - A. Review and Approval of June 16, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Motion to approve the June 16, 2022 meeting minutes by Pelletier. Seconded by Faust. Unanimous approval.

- 4. AT&T ESInet/NGCS Contract
  - A. 44 Participation Agreements have been signed as of August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022
  - B. 13 kickoff meetings have been held; more are being scheduled
  - C. 11 site surveys have been completed; more are being scheduled
  - D. 17 active PSAP projects with project managers assigned
  - E. The remaining PSAPs that have signed up are still in the initial data collection and project manager assignment phase
- 5. NextGen9-1-1 Grant Programs Update
  - A. PSAP Grant Program
    - 1) Grant guide and grant announcement was sent out
    - 2) \$6 million available this fiscal year
    - 3) Applications due October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022
    - 4) FAQ sheet is available
    - 5) There was some discussion about the requirements for the time for answering calls and the number of dispatchers on duty and available.
  - B. GIS Grant Program
    - 1) Grant policy and grant announcement were published
    - 2) A PSAP within the county must be signed up for AT&T ESInet or contracting for their own local/regional ESInet for NG911 services to be eligible to apply
    - 3) \$1.5 million available this fiscal year
    - 4) Applications due October 25th, 2022
- 6. Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Consultation on the NextGen9-1-1 Biennial Report

- A. Wis. Stats. § 256.35 (4) (g) requires DMA, in consultation with the 911 Subcommittee, to submit a report to the Governor and the Legislature on the status of NextGen9-1-1 implementation, operation, and maintenance.
- B. The report will be due November 1 of even numbered years, with the first report due November 1, 2022.
- C. There was discussion on the DMA suggested outline of topics to include in the report. There were suggestions to add the Federal Grant Program and PSAP consolidation efforts as additional items.
- D. There was also discussion about including a letter from the Subcommittee with the report.

Motion to approve the outline of topics to include in the NextGen9-1-1 Biennial Report and to include a letter from the 911 Subcommittee and Interoperability Council by Hardman. Seconded by Patterson. Unanimous approval.

## 7. SCIP Update

A. The Interoperability Council reviewed the draft SCIP at their meeting on July 28<sup>th</sup> but did not approve the draft during that meeting. There were some takeaway assignments given and the updated draft will be reviewed again and hopefully approved at their upcoming meeting on September 22<sup>nd</sup>.
